MACH (Music Art Creativity Hub) is a **very new project** of musical development and production **for young artists like you**, involving **tutors and internationally renowned musicians** from some of the most important orchestral companies such as the *Simon Bolivar Symphonie Orchestra*, the *Orchestra Mozart*, the *Lucerne Festival Orchestra*, and the *Orchestra dell'Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia*, in a course program of orchestra concerts, chamber music and individual instruction.

SESSIONS

INDIVIDUAL

Develop your instrumental **technique** and your **listening** ability based on the profound significance inherent in the score; liberate your **creative urge** through the art of **sound**.

MIME TALENT COACHING

Rediscover the **inherent gestures** that are hidden inside your body, **harmonize your creative drive** with the score you are studying by expressing physically the various elements within it.

ORCHESTRA

Enter into **contact** with other individuals, find a language suited for **communicating** and **creating together** a common vision, experiencing the wonder of an architecture of sound and reaching a level of profound listening.

MUSIC-ART DEVELOPING

Know and **explore** music more deeply striving to understand the **richness** of the **languages** that have stimulated its creation through encounters with **figurative artists, composers** and **musicologists** capable of helping you to develop a point of view, which is always **new** and **curious**.

CHAMBER MUSIC

Meet your tutors and the other musicians of the MACH Orchestra through the **profound and rich dialogue** that chamber music offers to fine-tune more and more your ability to listen.

In this second edition, **mach** Orchestra will address a classic and romantic symphonic repertoire.

Beethoven and Dvorak will be your travel companions in this edition of the MACH Orchestra and for the Closing Concert of the 2019 “Musica sull’Acqua” Festival. The *7th Symphony* and the *Concerto for Cello and Orchestra* are the two symphonic masterpieces chosen, concerted by **Diego Matheuz** and with the extraordinary participation of **Pablo Ferrández** on the cello.

The **2019** MACH includes an individual session with one of the tutors, chamber music for a total of 4 hours, mime talent coaching for a total of 2 hours, and music-art developing for a total of 2 hours.
